Curriculum Suggestions

Math

- Calculate postage with multiple postage stamps
- Calculate percentages of each stamp
- Calculate fractions of each stamp

Geography

- Plot each international postcard on a map
- Plot each domestic postcard on a map
- Use a distance calculator to determine how far a postcard has traveled
- Calculate how many days a postcard traveled
- Calculate an average of miles/km traveled per day.
- Convert miles to km and vice versa

Social Studies

- Study the cultures, food, traditions and rituals represented by the postcards
- Dress in traditional clothes and give a presentation of the postcard's country of origin
- Study the landmarks represented in international and domestic postcards
- Research the historical significance of the people represented on the postage stamp
- Research how people are chosen to be on postage stamps

Language Arts

- Practice printing and cursive writing
- Determine appropriate messages for a postcard
- Decide how to address and mail a postcard
- Determine how to affix the correct amount of postage

Visual Arts

- Design and make a handmade postcard
- Look for trends in postcard design—how are domestic and international postcards different?
- Design a postage stamp
- Look for trends in postage stamp design
- Design a postage stamp for a living person (who is chosen, how depicted on postage stamp)
